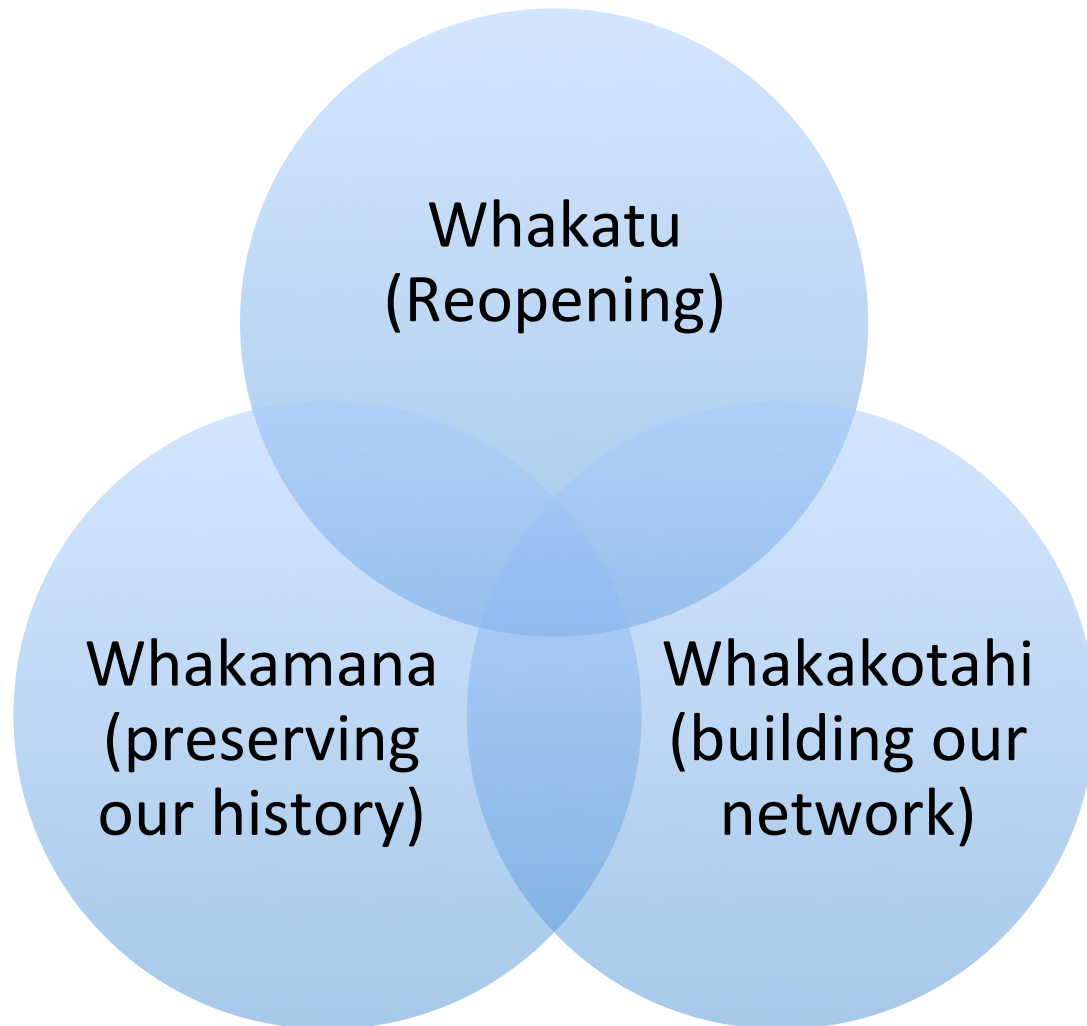

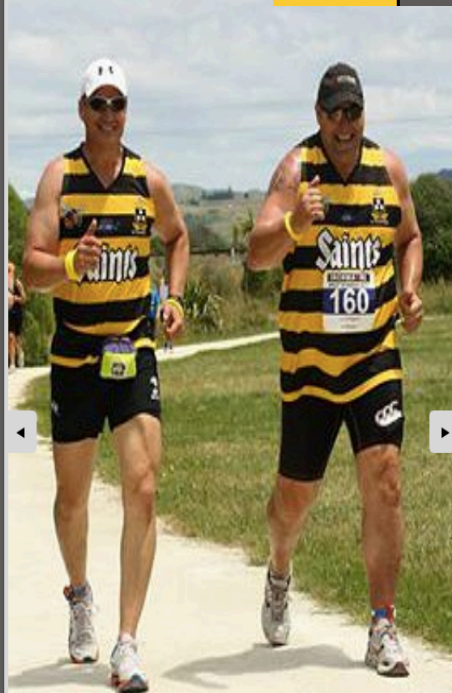

STEEPLECHASE

This year Selwyn House dominated the Senior grade. Eric Ranga, winner of the 1959 Junior grade, won the race in the record time of 20 minutes 35 seconds, cutting 20 seconds off the record created by David Catchpole last year. Maurice Leaman, also of Selwyn House, ran second, and John Moorfield of Panapa House came third. Eric Ranga led the entire distance and set a sizzling pace which Leaman and Moorfield did their best to match.

Josiah Walker of Pomare House won the Intermediate in the record time of 17 minutes 58 seconds, cutting 12 seconds off the record set by Murray Le Basse in 1959. Rutherford Bowles came in second after leading Walker for most of the course, and he was followed by Robin Cave.

In the Junior section, Kaipara Warbrick of Panapa House won the race, but he was 45 seconds outside the record previously set by Eric Ranga. Kana of Selwyn was second, and Koni of Pomare third.
